CALL FOR PAPERS

The journal is published in two issues of May and November annually. KAJAF is a double-blind peer reviewed journal published by the Department of Accounting, Faculty of Management Sciences, Federal University of Kashere, Gombe State – Nigeria. The Journal accepts papers in all areas of Accounting and Finance for publication which include but not limited to: Contemporary issues in Accounting and Finance, Accounting & Auditing Standards, Corporate Governance Issues, Corporate Social Responsibility, Green and Environmental Accounting, Accounting and Information Technology, Corporate Financial Reporting, Financial Reporting Quality/Earnings Management, Agricultural Accounting, Corporate Water Resources Accounting, Capital Market Studies, Auditing and Assurances/Investigation, Public Sector Accounting, Taxation and Revenue Administration, Sustainability Reporting Issue, Bankruptcy Prediction, Corporate and Personal Finance, Forensic Accounting, Capital Structure and Working Capital Management, Enterprises and Corporate Risk Management Banking, Insurance and Islamic Finance.

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION AND MANUSCRIPT FORMAT

The submission language is English and must be a well-researched original manuscript that has not previously been submitted elsewhere for publication. The paper should not exceed 18 pages on A4 type paper in MS-word format, one line spacing, 12 font size in Times New Roman. Manuscript should be tested for plagiarism before submission, as the maximum similarity index acceptable by KAJAF is 20 percent. Furthermore, the length of a complete article should not exceed 7000 words including an abstract of not more than 275 words with a minimum of six keywords. All references including in-text citation and reference list, tables and figures should be in line with APA 7th edition publication manual. Finally, manuscript should be submitted to our email address kajaf2021@fukashere.edu.ng.

PUBLICATION PROCEDURE

After receiving a manuscript that is within the similarity index threshold, a confirmation email will be sent together with a request to pay a review processing fee. At this point, the editorial board will take a decision on accepting, rejecting or making a resubmission of the manuscript based on the outcome of the double-blind peer review. Those authors whose manuscript were accepted for publication will be asked to pay a publication fee, after effecting all suggested corrections and changes made on the manuscript. All corrected papers returned within the specified timeframe will be published in that issue. While those unreturned will be taken to next immediate issue as the case maybe.
